



Schools H₂O Walk for Water

Now you've seen how big the problem is you can help by raising money to dig wells and build loos.

The big idea of the H₂O Walk for Water is to have some fun, raise some funds and raise awareness of water issues – and to walk from somewhere starting with 'H' to somewhere starting with 'O'.



This can be a place that starts with 'H' (Henleaze), or a road name (Hawthorn Drive), or a thing (the Hall) - or even someone's house (Henry's house).

You could even just have a sign that says 'H' and another one that says 'O' and walk from one to the other!

The walk doesn't have to be long – it's great exercise and a chance to involve the whole school.

Why don't you involve carrying some water – a relay race from 'H' to 'O' that involves passing a cup or a bucket of water from person to person?

Or the walk could be sponsored by the amount of water that is moved from 'H' to 'O'?

Alternatively you might carry one heavier water carrier on your heads and be sponsored for the distance you can get it? (we may be able to loan you a large plastic water carrier – please email us) – or you could do a long walk and share carrying the water.

Other bright ideas to raise funds would be to have a non-uniform day – perhaps even everyone dressing in blue or painting their faces blue?

How about spending a penny to spend a penny? – encouraging donations to use the loo and so raising money to build loos for people who don't have them.
